Decree of April 15, 1848, No. 700

Eugenio

Prince of Savoy-Carignano

Lieutenant General of his Majesty's crown lands in His Majesty's absence

By virtue of the authority vested in us:

Given the Royal Decree of March 29, 1848, which admits the Israelites of the Kingdom to the enjoyment of all civil rights.

Following the proposal of the Prime Minister, charged with the portfolio of the Ministry of War and of the Navy, we have ordained and do ordain:

Israelitic subjects will henceforth be admitted to take part in military service, in conformity with existing laws and disciplines.

We waive all laws or dispositions contrary to the present. The Prime Minister charged with the portfolio of the Ministry of War and of the Navy will see to the execution of the present, which will be registered at the General Control registry, published and inserted in the Acts of Government.

Given at Turin, this day of April 15, 1848.
