DEECREE OF JUNE 19, 1848 (N. 735)

Eugenio Prince of Savoy-Carignano Lieutenant General of his Majesty's crown lands in His Majesty's absence

Intending to eliminate all doubts about the civil and political competence of those citizens, who do not practice the Catholic Religion,

The Senate and the Chamber of Deputies have adopted,

We, by virtue of the authority delegated to us, have ordained and do ordain as follows,

One article:

Difference of cult does not constitute an exception to the enjoyment of civil and political rights, and to access to civil and military offices.

The Ministers Secretaries of State are charged with the execution of the present law in aspects pertaining to their office, which law will be published and integrated into the corpus of the Acts of Government.

Given at Turin, this day of June 19, 1848.
